Location

This year our international workshop is held in Braga. Braga is a city located in the northwestern part of Portugal, 55 kilometers northeast of Porto. Braga is known for its rich history, beautiful architecture, and religious heritage, which make it a popular destination for tourists. The official language of Braga, like the rest of Portugal, is Portuguese. However, as a popular tourist destination, many people in Braga also speak English, especially in hotels, restaurants, and other tourist-oriented establishments. In addition, some people in Braga may also speak Spanish or other languages, especially if they work in the tourism industry or have had exposure to foreign languages through travel or education. Weather


In the middle of June, Braga, Portugal experiences warm and sunny weather, as it is in the summer season. The average high temperature during the day is around 25°C (77°F), while the average low temperature at night is around 14°C (57°F). It is typically an enjoyable destination to visit at this time because the weather is warm and comfortable without being overly hot, and there is typically an abundance of sunshine and minimal rainfall. However, it is always a good idea to check the weather forecast closer to your travel dates, as temperatures and weather conditions can vary from year to year, please visit **www.accuweather.com**.

Visa

Portugal is in the European Union, so it is in the Schengen travel area. Many visitors to Portugal will require a **Short Stay Visa** to enter the country. You can check whether or not you require a visa on this page <u>here</u>.

Finance

Credit cards are widely accepted everywhere in Portugal, with **Visa** and **Mastercard** being the most popular. Acceptance of American Express and Diners cards is decidedly lower and JCB cards are nearly unknown. You can use your local cards in ATMs with Visa, Master Card, Cirrus, JCB, Union Pay access. Money changers can be

found at the airport and local licensed money changers in major cities including Braga/Porto. For participants from countries that do not have access to those financial services, please arrange accordingly for your own convenience. Major currencies are accepted by money changers and banks.

Communication

Complimentary Wi-Fi is available at Portugal airports, hotels and University of Minho, and in many cases, restaurants and other public areas. Although Wi-Fi is free, log-in is still needed. As for telephone, international connections are available. Please check your service provider prior to your departure.

International Travel and Local Transportation:

Braga is in the northwestern part of Portugal. There are 3 international airports – Porto (50 km distant), Lisbon (350 km distant) and Faro (600 km distant).

• From Porto airport:

<u>By taxi:</u> Taxis are readily available at the airport and offer a convenient and direct way to get to the University of Minho. The trip takes around 35-40 minutes and may cost around 40-50 euros.

<u>By bus:</u> You can take a bus from the airport to the University of Minho by first taking the "GetBus" shuttle from the airport to Braga bus station (https://www.getbus.eu/en/), and then taking bus number 43 to the "University of Minho" stop. The trip takes around 1.5 hours and may cost around 10 euros.

<u>By train</u>: You can take the metro from the airport to the "São Bento" train station (<u>https://en.metrodoporto.pt/get</u>), then take the train to Braga (<u>https://www.cp.pt/passageiros/en</u>) and then taking bus number 43 to the "University of Minho" stop (https://tub.pt/percurso/43/). The trip takes around 2 hours and may cost around 10 euros.

Dress Code

We encourage visitors to dress decently when visiting Braga and other public areas. In the workshop, the dress code is smart/formal. For the trip, we recommend casual clothes and comfortable shoes.
